HAZMAT OPERATIONAL PERMIT APPLICATION

The following fees are hereby established for obtaining permits from the Matagorda County Fire Marshal's Office. Acceptable forms of payment are paper checks or money orders (made out to Matagorda County). Fees will be paid prior to the start of the process for which the fee is charged. All fees paid to the Matagorda County Fire Marshal's Office are non-refundable. This includes existing facilities and sites. **All Hazmat Operational Permits are required annually.**

Aerosol Products (IFC 2021 – 105.5.2) - An operational permit is required to manufacture, store or handle an aggregate quantity of Level 2 or Level 3 aerosol products, aerosol cooking spray products or plastic aerosol 3 products in excess of 500 pounds (227kg) net weight.	\$200		
Cellulose Nitrate Film (ICF 2021 – 105.5.6) An operational permit is required to store, handle, or use cellulose nitrate film in Group A occupancy.	\$200		
Combustible Dust Producing Operations (IFC 2021 – 105.5.7) An operational permit is required to operate a grain elevator, flour starch mill, feed mill, or a plant pulverizing aluminum, coal, cocoa, magnesium, spices or sugar, or other operations producing combustible dusts as defined in Chapter 2. Annual	\$200		
Combustible Fibers (IFC 2021 – 105.5.8) - An operational permit is required for the storage and handling of combustible fibers in quantities greater than 100 cubic feet (2.8 m3).	\$200		
Compressed Gases (IFC 2021 – 105.5.9) An operational permit is required for storage, use or handling at normal temperature and pressure (NTP) of compressed gases in excess of the amounts listed in table 105.5.9 of the adopted code.	\$200		
Cryogenic Fluids (IFC 2021 – 105.5.11) An operational permit is required to produce, store, transport on site, use, handle or dispense cryogenic fluids in excess of the amounts listed in Table 105.5.11 of the IFC 2021.	\$200		
Dry Cleaning (IFC 105.5.13) An operational permit is required to engage in the business of dry cleaning or to change to a more hazardous cleaning solvent used in existing dry-cleaning equipment.	\$200		
Explosives (IFC 2021 – 105.5.16) An operational permit is required for the manufacturer, storage, handling, sale or use of any quantity of explosives, explosive materials, fireworks or pyrotechnics special effects within the scope of chapter 56 of the adopted code.	\$300		
Hazardous Materials (IFC 2021 – 105.5.22) An operational permit is required to store, transport on site, dispense, use or handle hazardous materials in excess of the amounts listed in table 105.5.22 of the adopted code.	\$300		
Electrical Energy Storage System (ESS,BESS and other) (IFC 2024-1207) Operational permits shall be obtained for stationary EES installations per individual system or separate enclosed systems.	\$500 Per System or enclosure		
Solar Photovoltaic System (solar panel systems) IFC 2024-1205 Solar panel collection stations/locations that are connected to ESS or other type of electrical storage systems	\$100 per Acre
